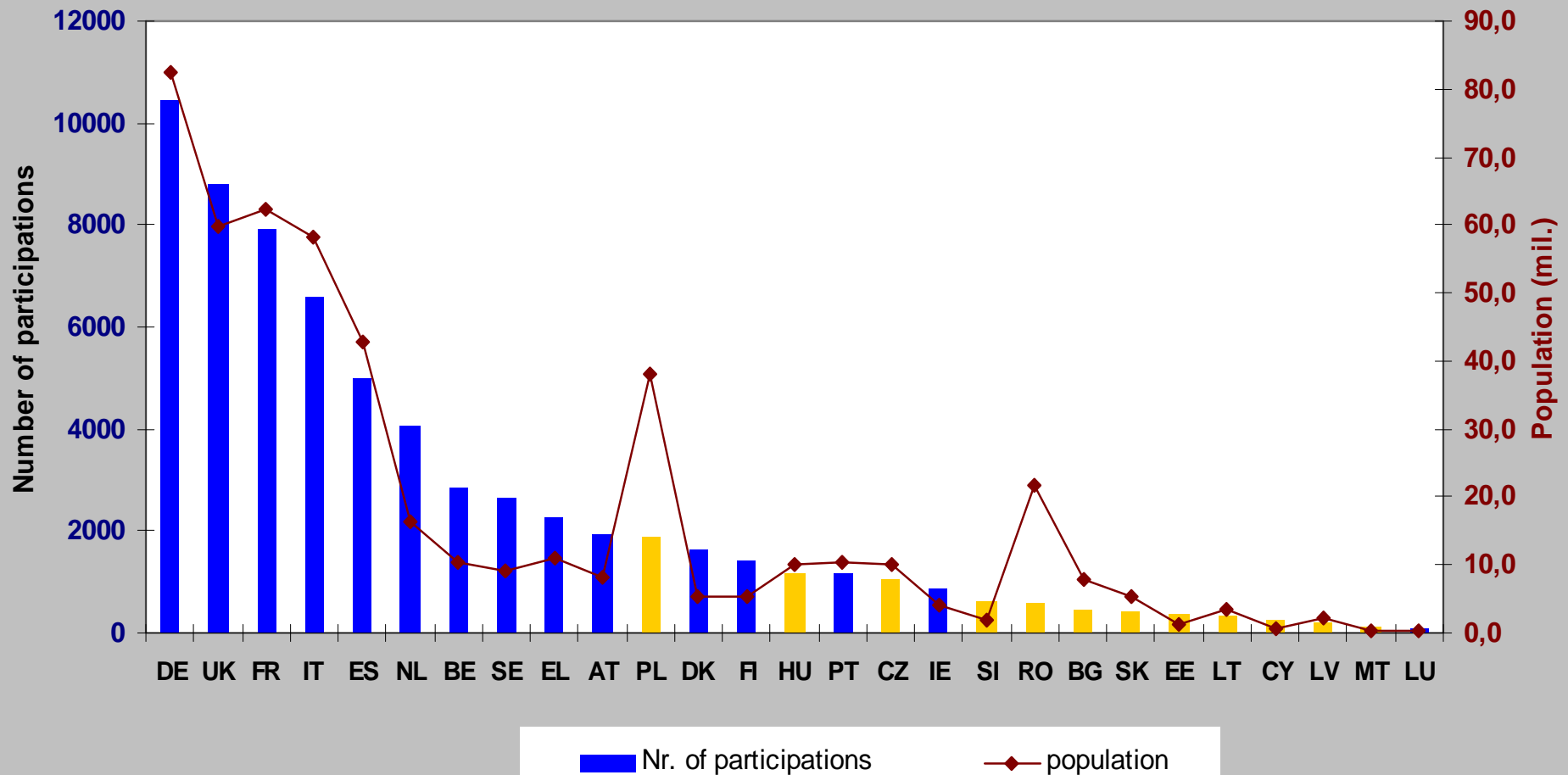

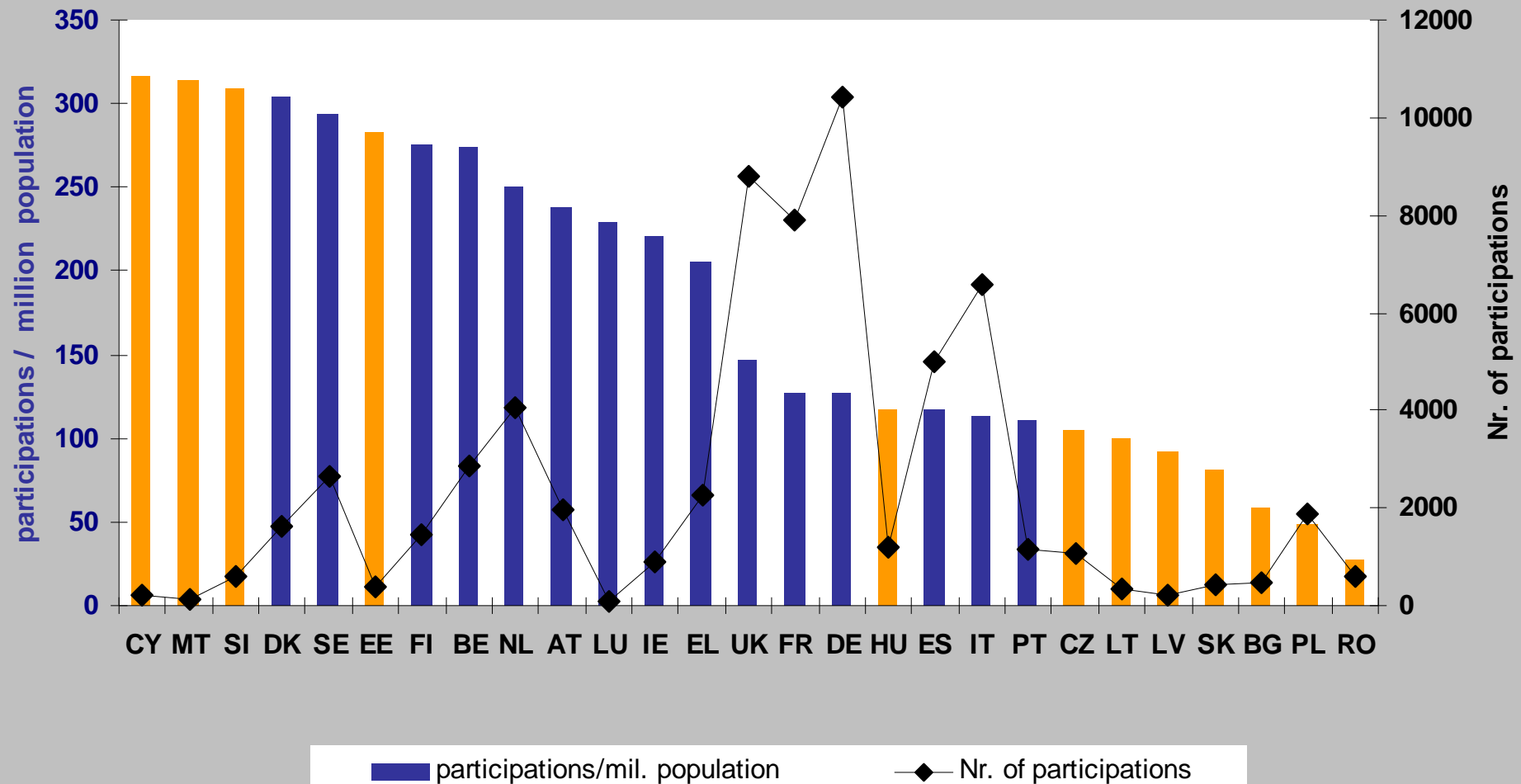

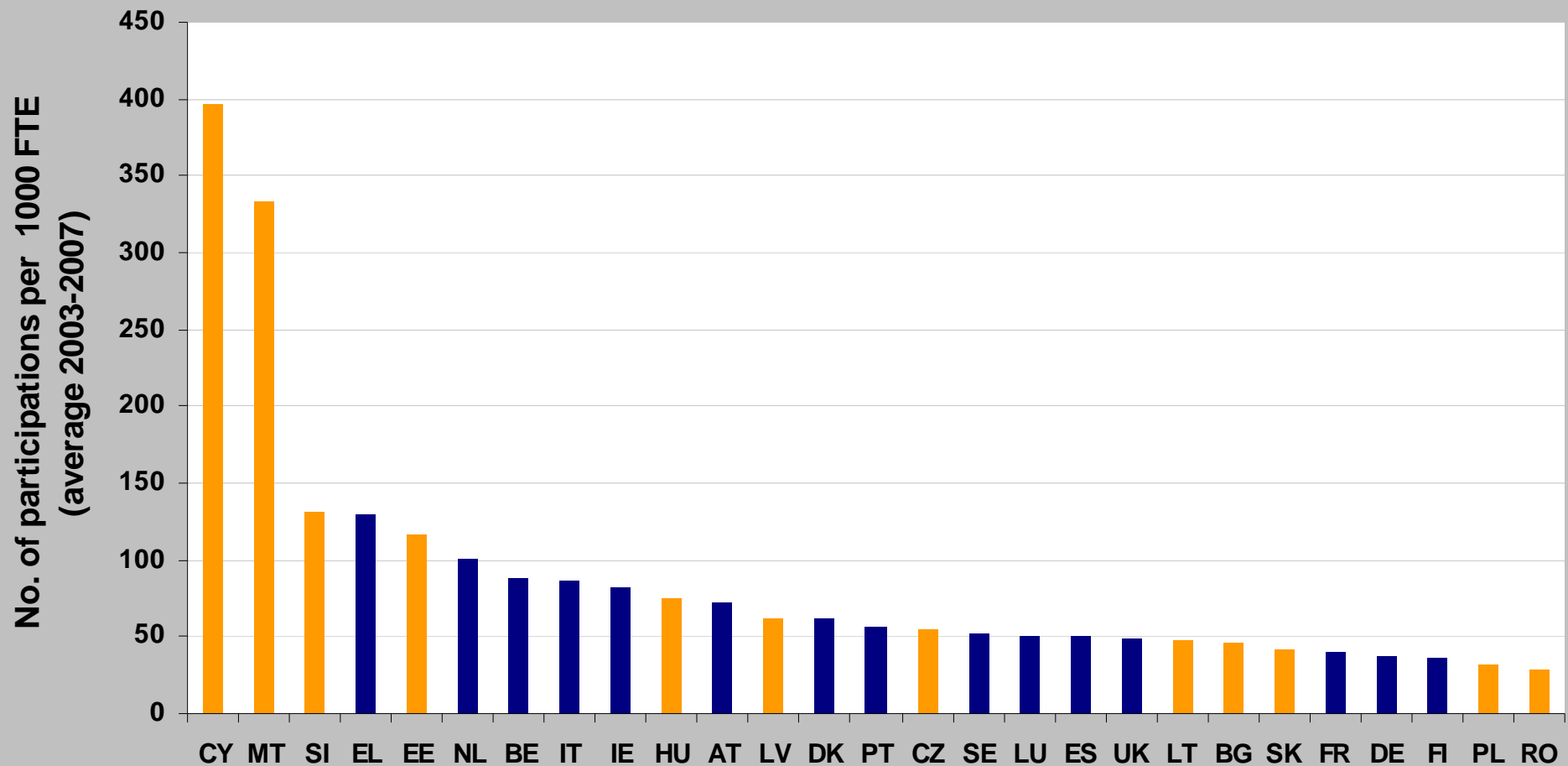
Indicator: Number of participations



Indicator: Number of participations per 1 million population

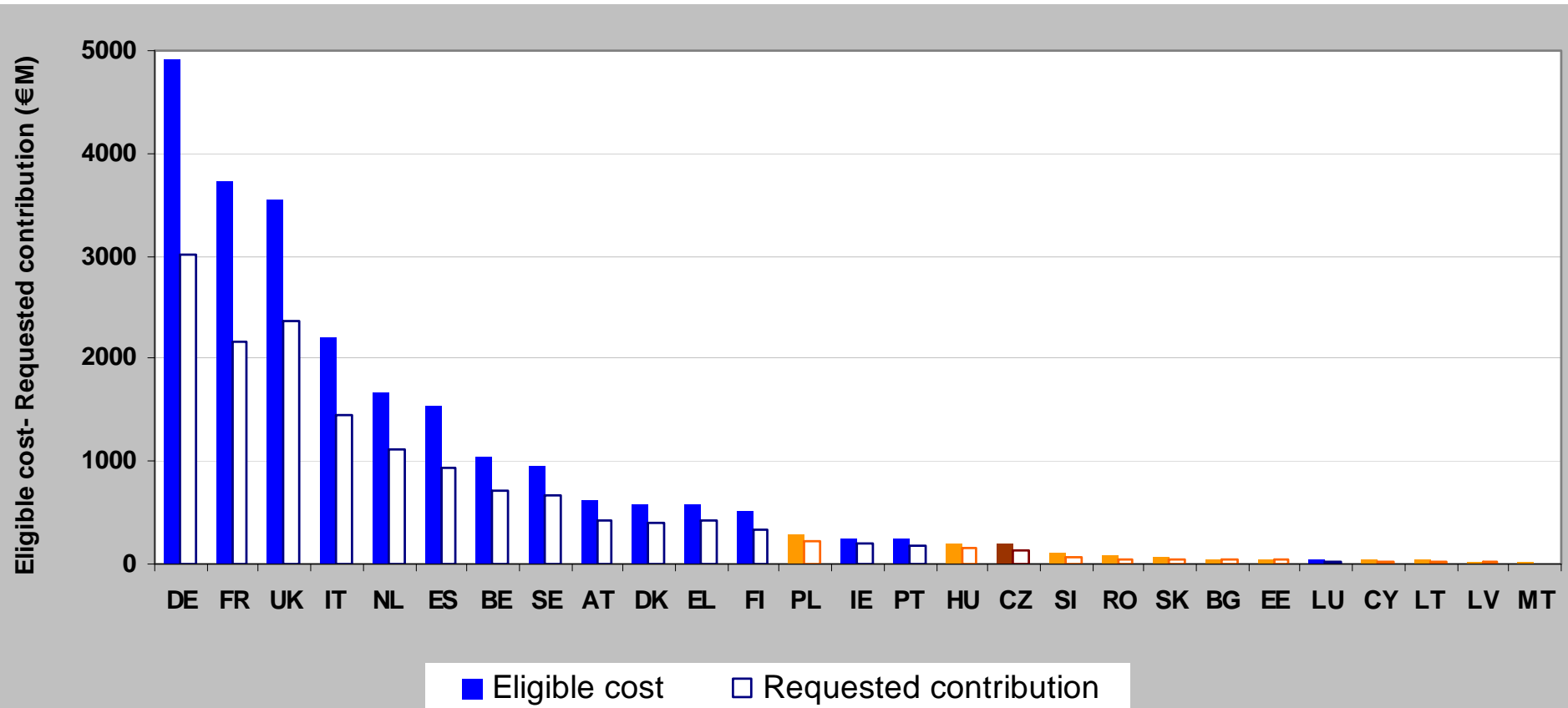


Indicator: participations per 1000 researchers (FTE)

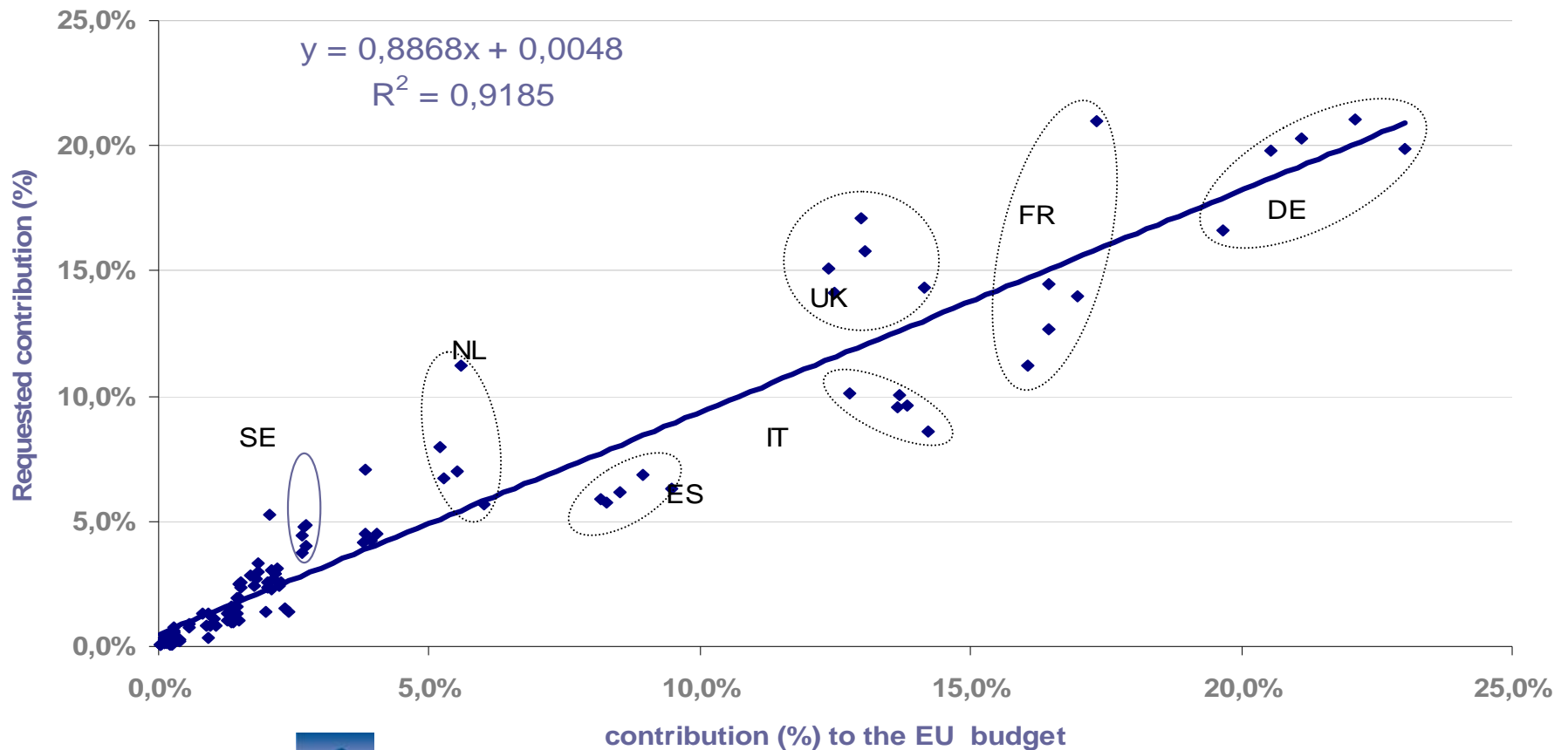

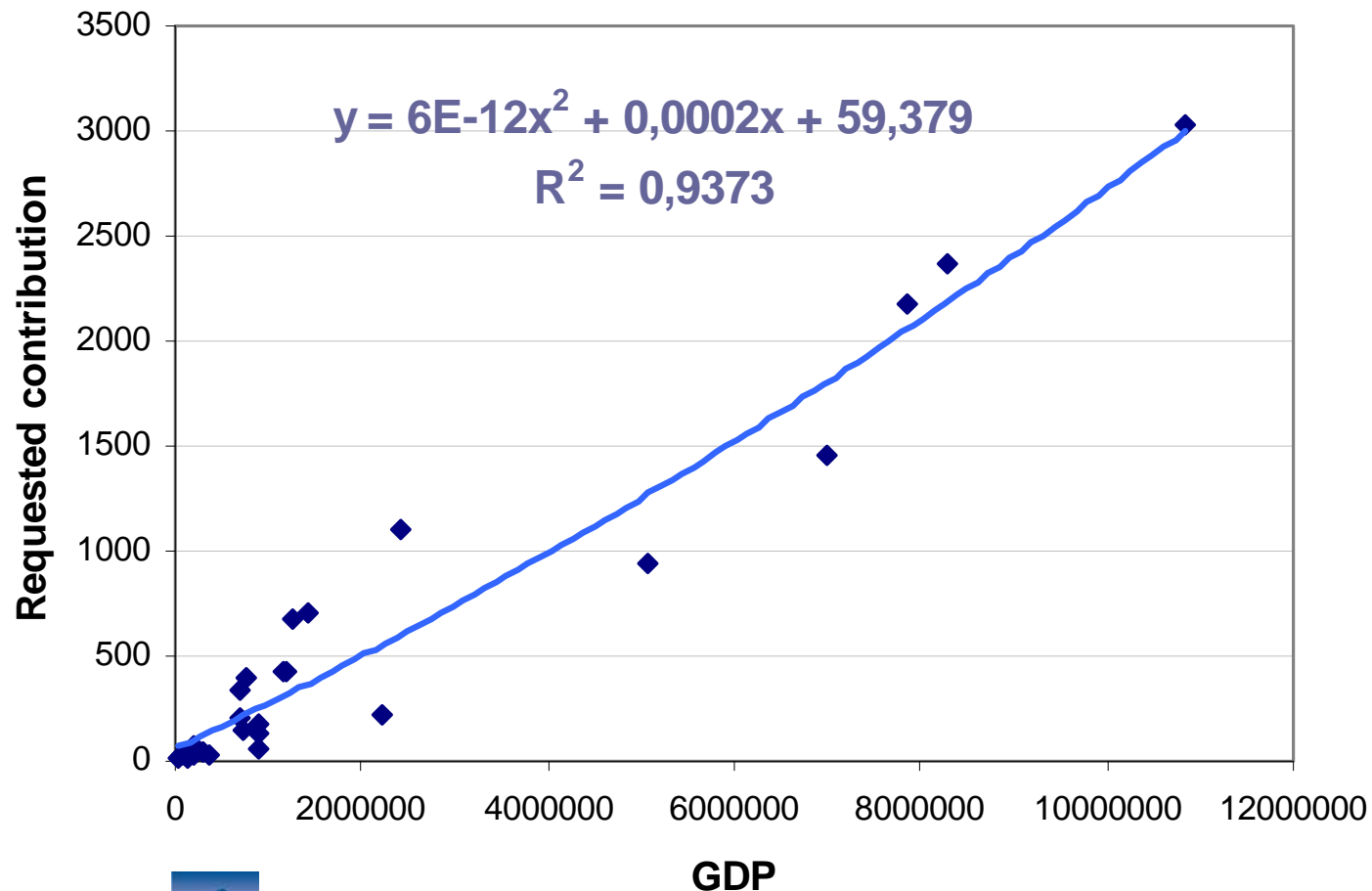
Eligible cost , Requested contribution



Framework programme: the portion the MS contributes to the EU budget ~ the portion the MS requests from the FP budget?

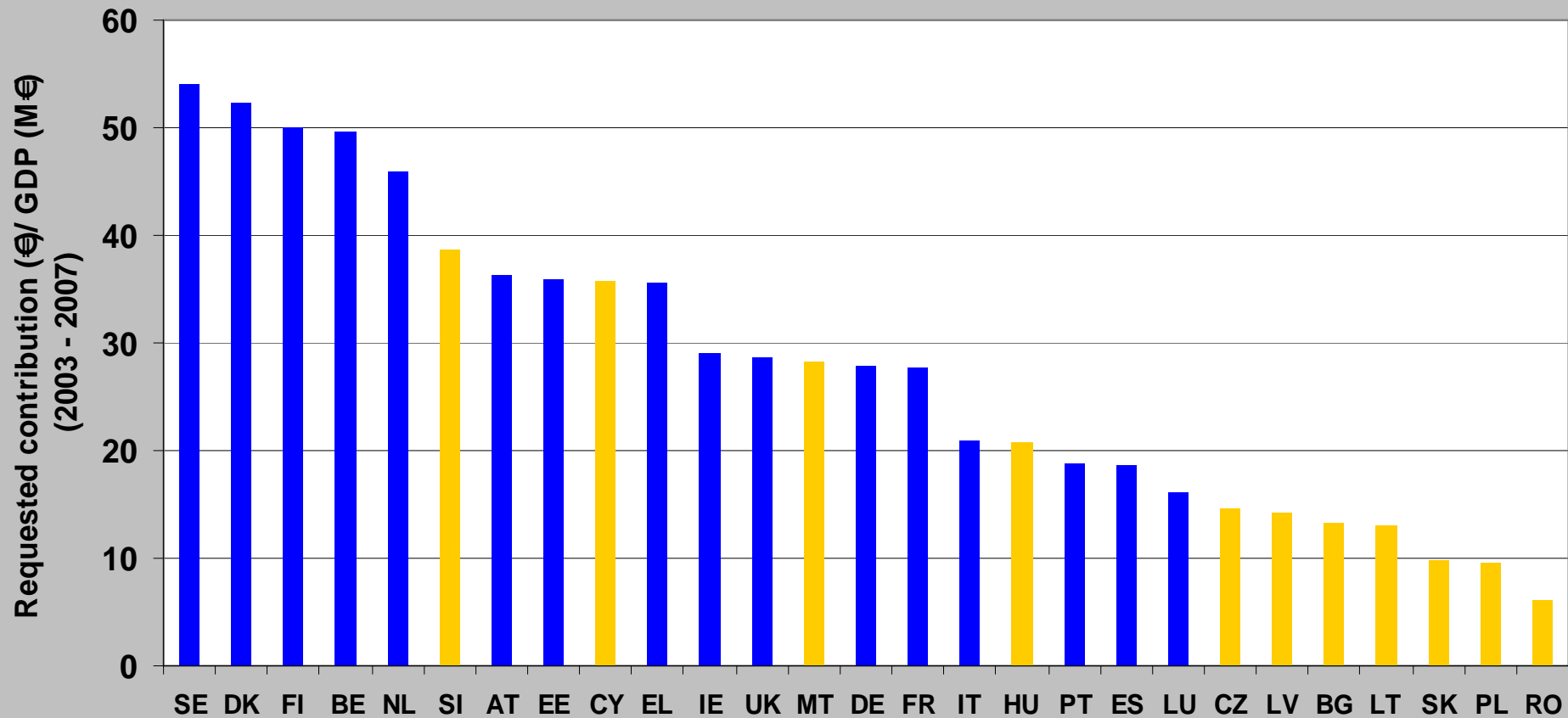


Dependence of the Requested contribution on the GDP

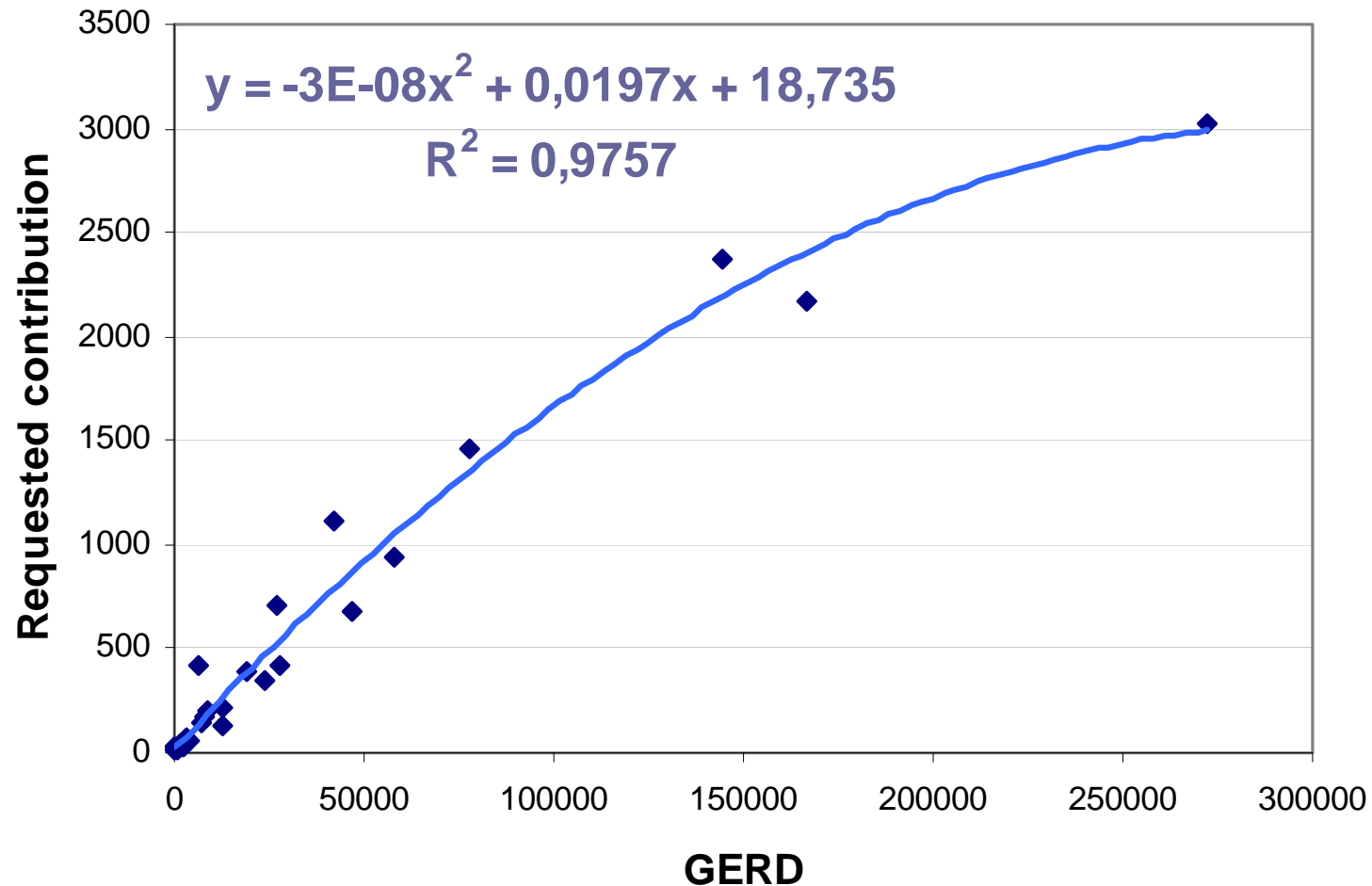

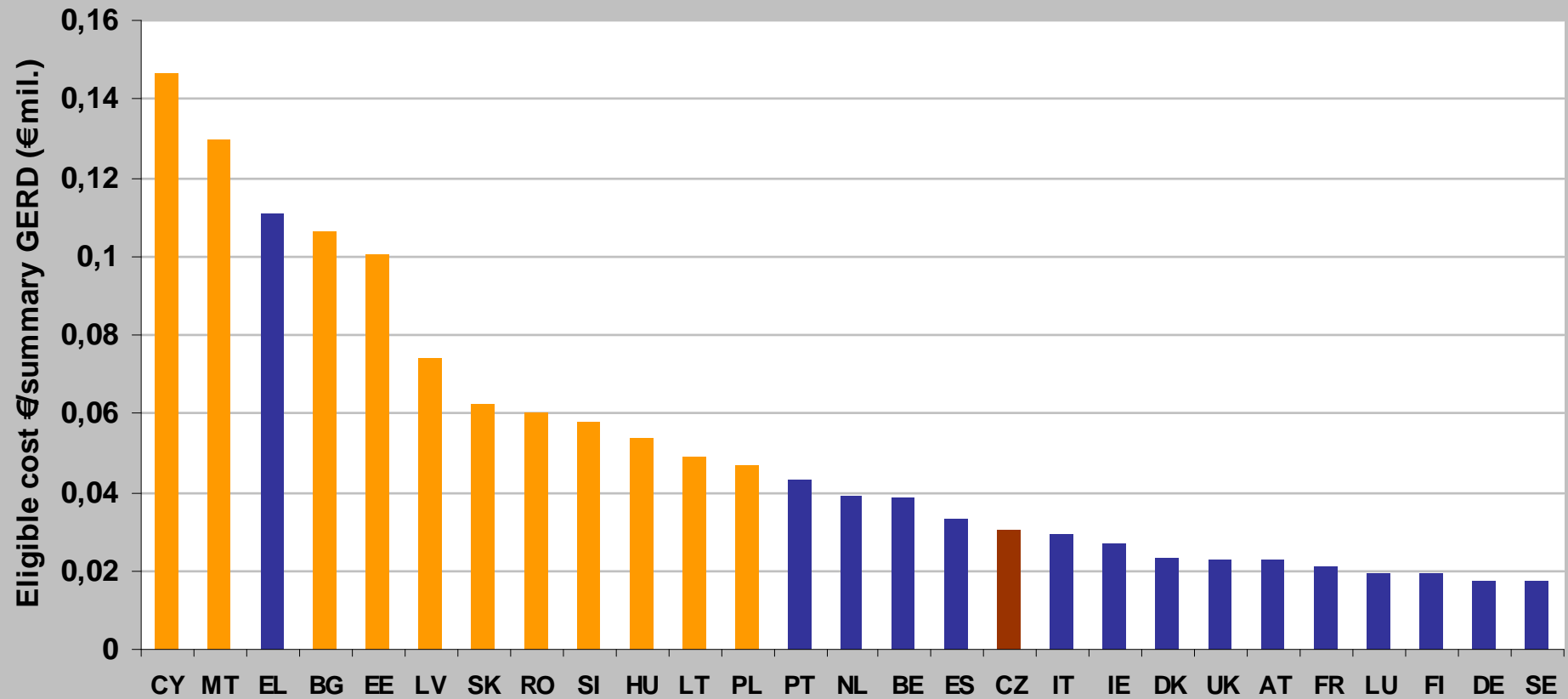
Requested contribution(€) / GDP (M€)



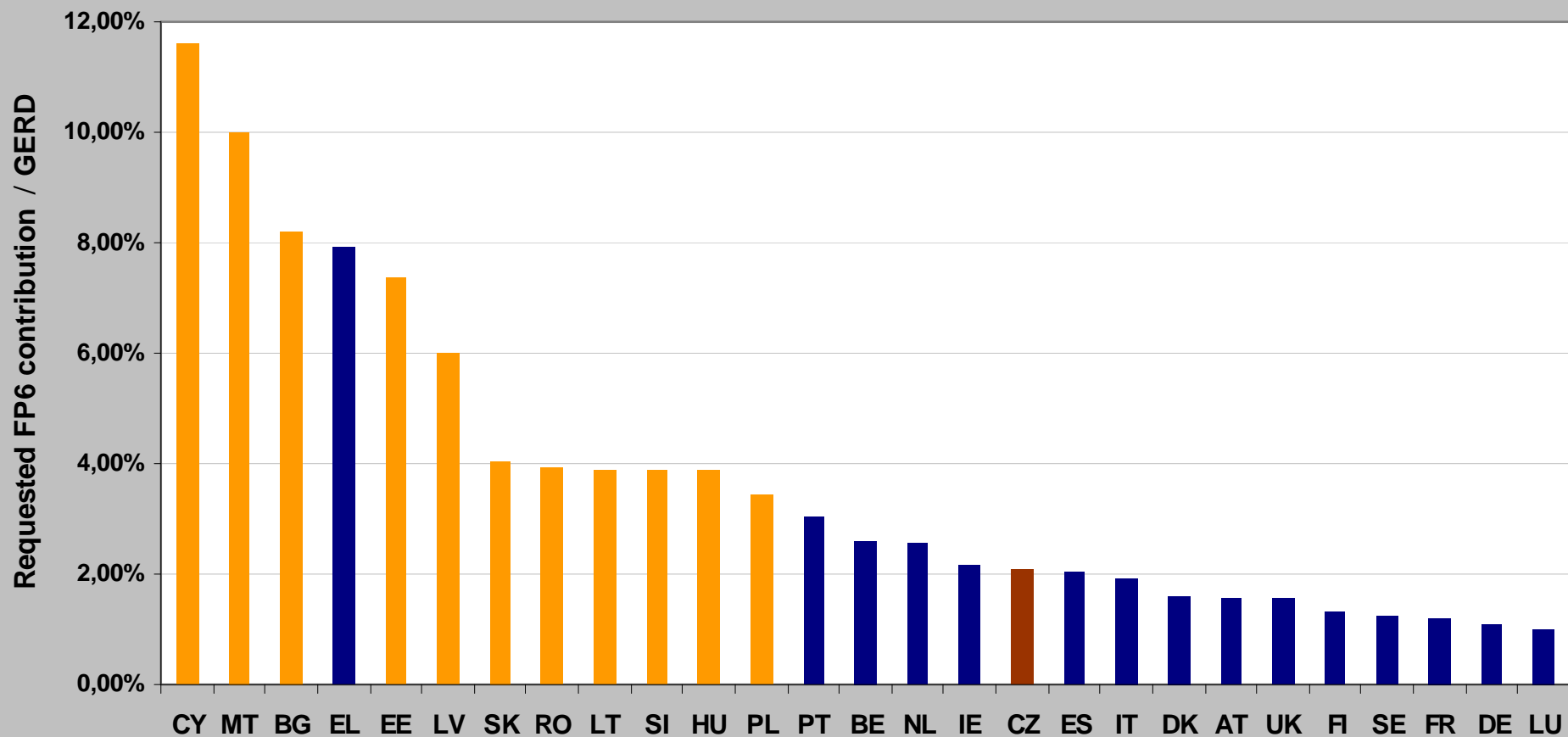
Dependence of the Requested contribution on the GERD



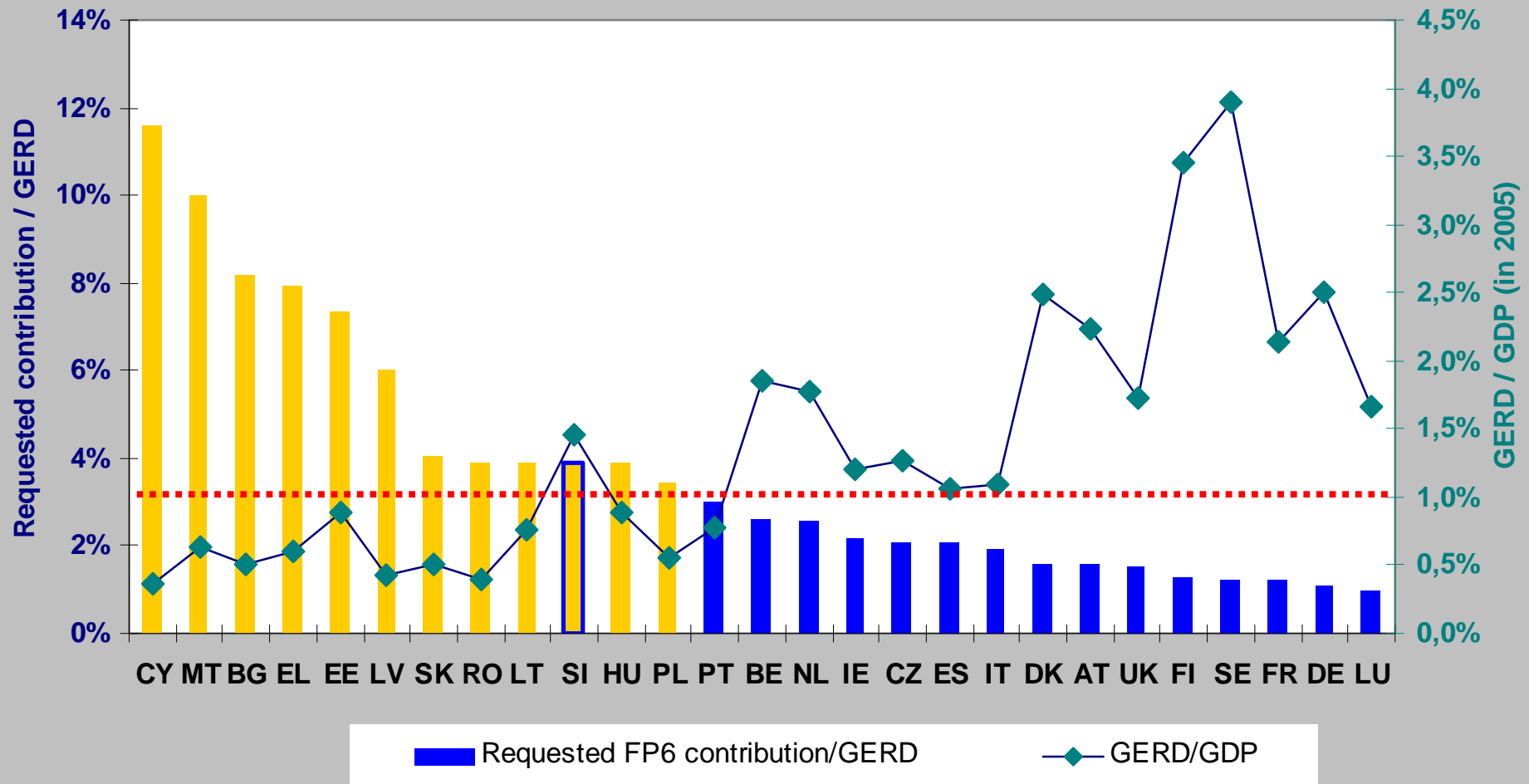
Indicator: Eligible cost/GERD

Conclusions

- ✚ The „absolute“ indicators (i.e. number of participations, total requested indicators do not convey „FP specific information“
- ✚ The relative indicators convey specific information on countries participation in the FP. However, their construction is not so obvious and requires further analysis. Minimum set of relative indicators should be defined.
- ✚ The relative indicators can help to the MS which seek for measures aimed at more effective participation in the FP.
