The event will focus on presentations and discussions regarding the issue of methodology for evaluations and impact assessment studies, so that results are comparable and allow an overall synthesis giving a global view of what has been achieved with the FPs. The Workshop will include a Commission's presentation of its organization and evaluation strategy, contributions from experts in public policy evaluation, presentation of existing studies and approaches at the levels of the EU institutions, member states and stakeholders. Attention will be also given to lessons on how to implement the outcome of evaluation.

By the end of this year, several evaluation studies will be published. Some of them, like FP6 expost evaluation report for IST activities, JRC evaluation report, a report on the future of networks of excellence and a Swedish national impact study, will be presented at the workshop. This event will serve as a preparatory meeting for "EU FOrum on Research and Development Impact Assessment" conference, which will take place in Prague on 24-25 February 2009 in the framework of the Czech Republic's EU presidency. Exchange of the knowledge can be also an interesting aspect for inputs for the forthcoming midterm review of the framework programme and of the financial perspectives.
